Scholarship Criteria

The illy scholarship is dedicated to assisting an individual interested in pursuing or furthering a career in the culinary arts. Those interested in applying for a scholarship should fulfill the following criteria and return the attached form and required materials to Christopher Papagni by *Tuesday, September 7, 2010*.

1. An essay no longer than 500 words explaining why you are choosing this particular program (typed and double spaced). Please let us know what Italian products you like to use and why? Lastly, what are your goals upon completion of the course?
2. Your resumé.
3. Two letters of recommendation from: a) a food industry professional; b) a previous employer or educational program or character reference (non-family).
4. Minimum age limit; 18 years.
5. Awarding scholarship funds is contingent on a letter of acceptance to The Italian Culinary Academy.
6. The recipient will be expected make every effort to attend illy's Università del Caffè Coffee Expert course at The International Culinary Center. Upon completion of the course, recipient will write a two-page report on his or her experience in all aspects of the course.
7. Recipient will agree to serve as spokesperson and have their name used for public relations and marketing purposes with regards to their UDC course experience.

Scholarship awards will be decided upon by both illy and The Italian Culinary Academy. Winner will be announced by mail on *Monday, September 20, 2010*.
